___ Read, review, and otherwise familiarize yourself with all pages handed out in class.

___ Practice OUTLOUD at least 15 minutes/day and record on Oral Practice Accountability Sheet.

___ Memorize I Corintios 15:3-4.

___ Memorize Proverbio #11: Él que rompe paga.

___ Aprenda los nombres de los continentes, los océanos y mares, los ríos, los países y las capitales del mundo hispanoamericano, y las nacionalidades.
