PANAMA – Panama City

...and these larger islands in the Caribbean:

CUBA – Havana  
JAMAICA – Kingston  
HAITI – Port-au-Prince  
DOMINICAN REPUBLIC – Santo Domingo  
PUERTO RICO – San Juan
