CLASS FEE INFORMATION:

Class fees are based on the complete program from September through May. This program includes class time, curriculum selection, course development, assignments and worksheets, grading, communication with absent students, family support and the costs of overhead and materials. Since the program includes all these areas, fees are due regardless of class attendance.

Each class also requires a \$50 Materials Fee per year payable on or before the first day of class. There is no registration fee but space is limited so register early to ensure your place.

Graphic Design: Tuesdays 11am to NOON. FEE \$40/month (Junior High and High School)

In this class, using computer software and online programs, students will produce a variety of visual arts projects, including advertising copy, word art, posters, brochures, business cards, and more. In the process they will analyze and redesign ads, study color theory, the color wheel, advertising copy, discuss themes, moods, audience, persuasion, and purpose. After a semester of instruction, students will participate in a series of design contests to practice and refine their skills. Students may earn up to 1 high school credit.

Basic Computing Skills Class: Wednesdays NOON to 1pm. FEE \$40/mo. (Grades 5+)

For students who have few or limited computer skills, this class is designed to introduce you to the multitude of computing possibilities. Focusing first on Basic Keyboarding, Microsoft Word, Microsoft Excel, Power Point and the Internet, lessons the first semester will strengthen basic skills. The second semester will focus on using the computing skills learned to produce a research paper, including supervised internet research, data presented in an Excel spreadsheet and graphed or charted, an optional Power Point presentation, and a works cited sheet, including how to cite information from website resources. High School Students may earn up to 1 credit in Computer Skills, Occupational Education, or other.

Computer Aided Drafting: Wednesdays 1-2:30. FEE \$56/mo. (High School)

Prerequisite: Drafting and Design I or special permission from the instructor.

Here it is! The opportunity for students interested in Architecture and/or Engineering to go digital! Using CAD programs, students will be introduced to the world of digital drafting. Students will learn how to use layering systems, how the drawing tools and toolbars work, how to draw and edit, add text and notes, dimensions, printing and saving, and introduce 3D capabilities. After a semester of basic skill instruction, students will copy an entire set of plans, and design a building and the set of construction documents to accompany it. This course may require students to work in the computer lab outside of regularly scheduled class time. Students may earn up to 1 high school credit.

Digital Art Studio: Wednesdays 2:30-4pm. FEE \$56/mo. (Junior High and High School)

Here is a chance to stretch your student's creative wings. Using online art programs and computer software programs, this class will challenge your student to experiment with digital designs. Each quarter we will focus on specific design topics, like composition, order/chaos, color theory, etc. and produce visual arts masterpieces. Projects will include collages, photo editing, mosaics, and more. This course may require students to work in the computer lab outside of regularly scheduled class time. The year-long course will run approximately the same schedule as the HomeLink calendar. Students may earn up to 1 high school credit.
